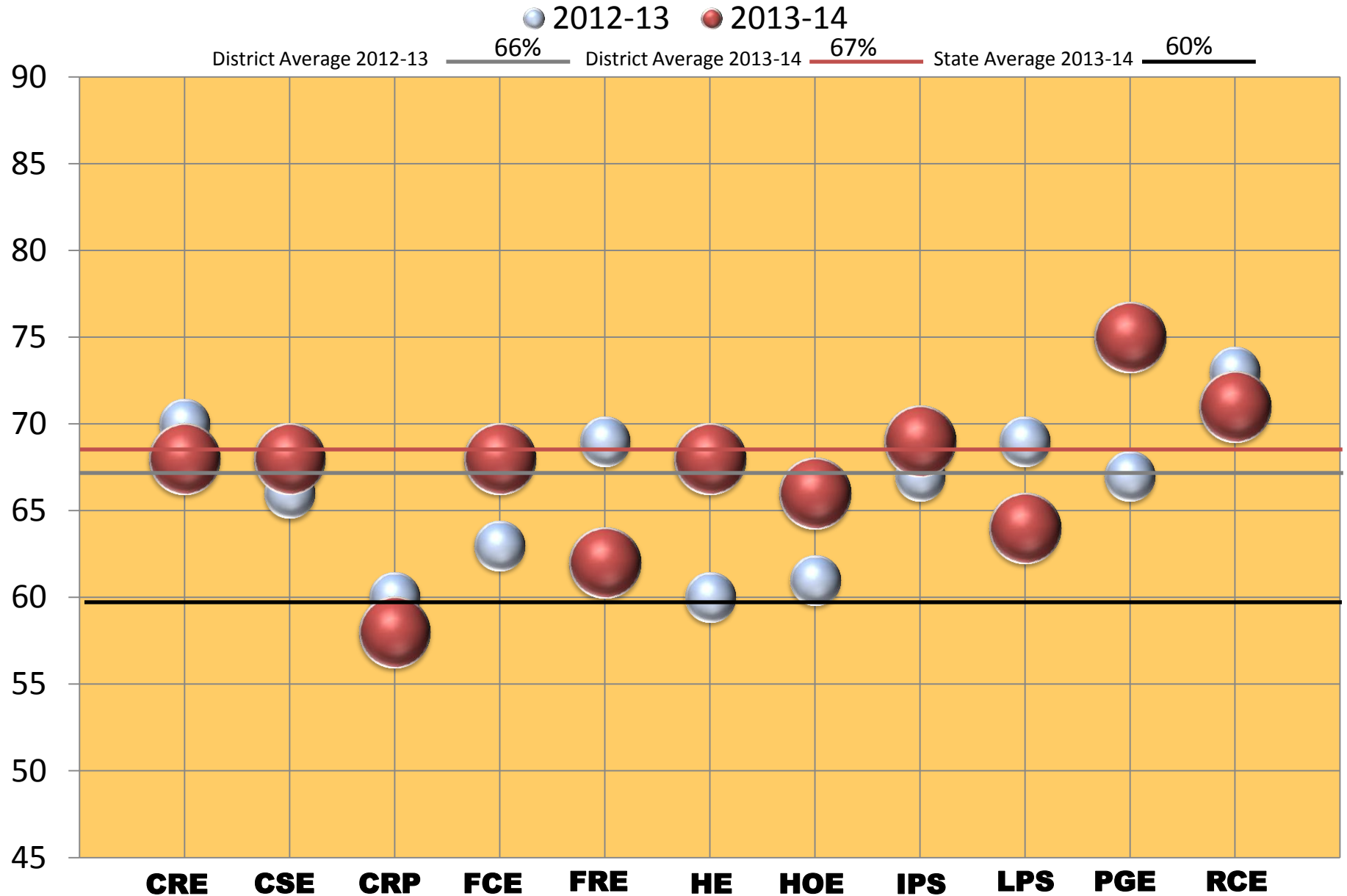

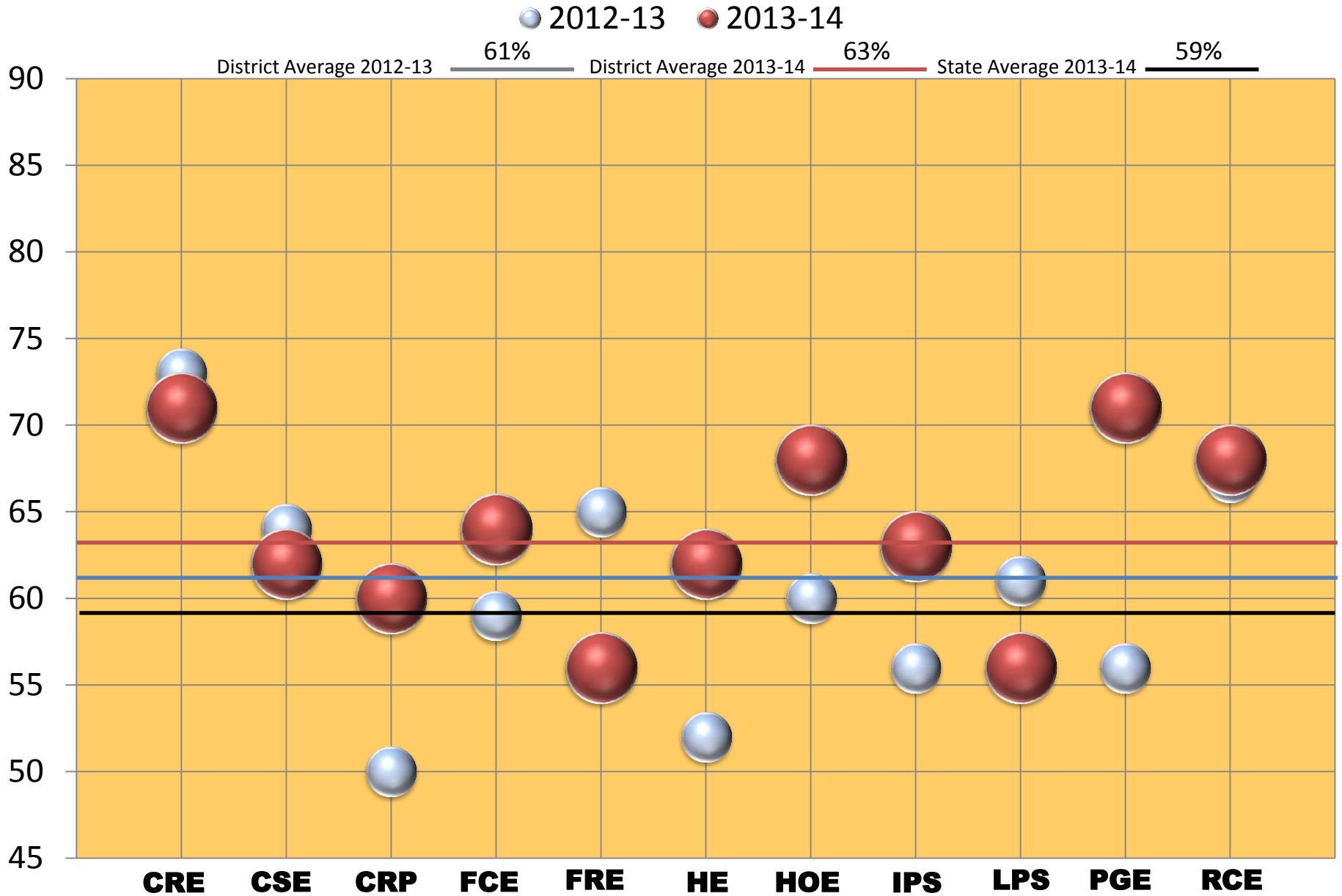

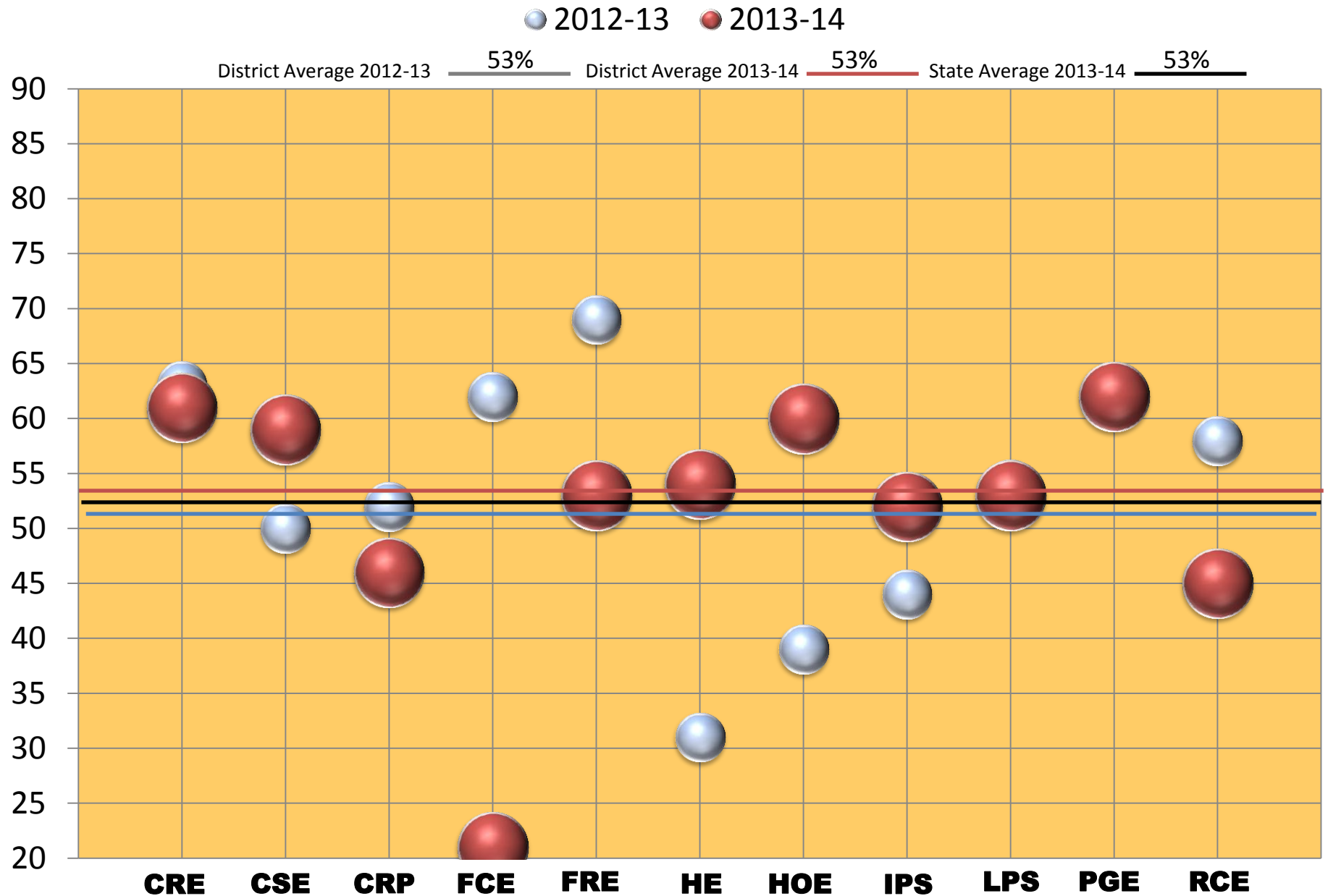
# FCAT 2.0 READING: Percent Proficient Grades 3-5



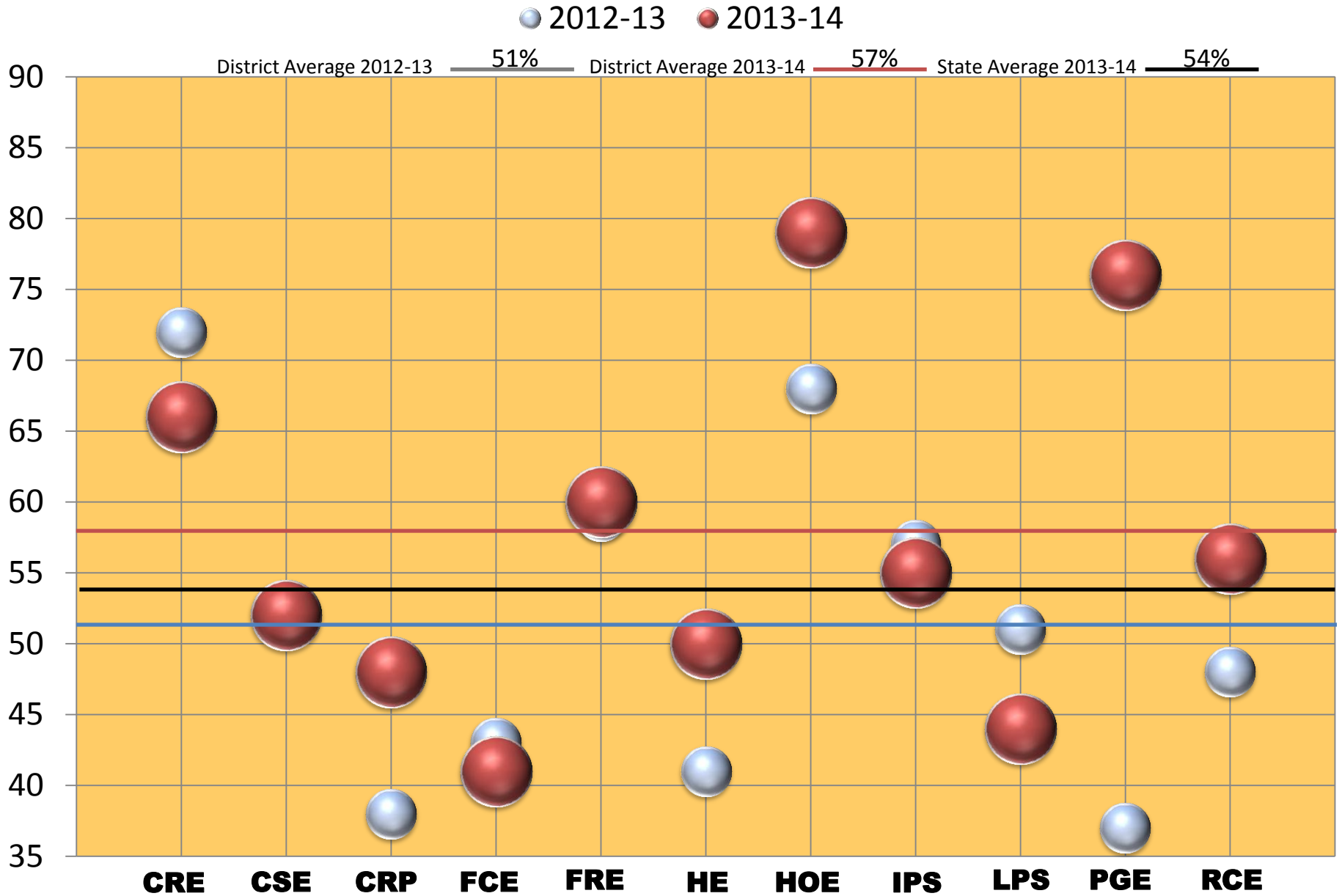
# FCAT 2.0 MATH: Percent Proficient Grades 3-5



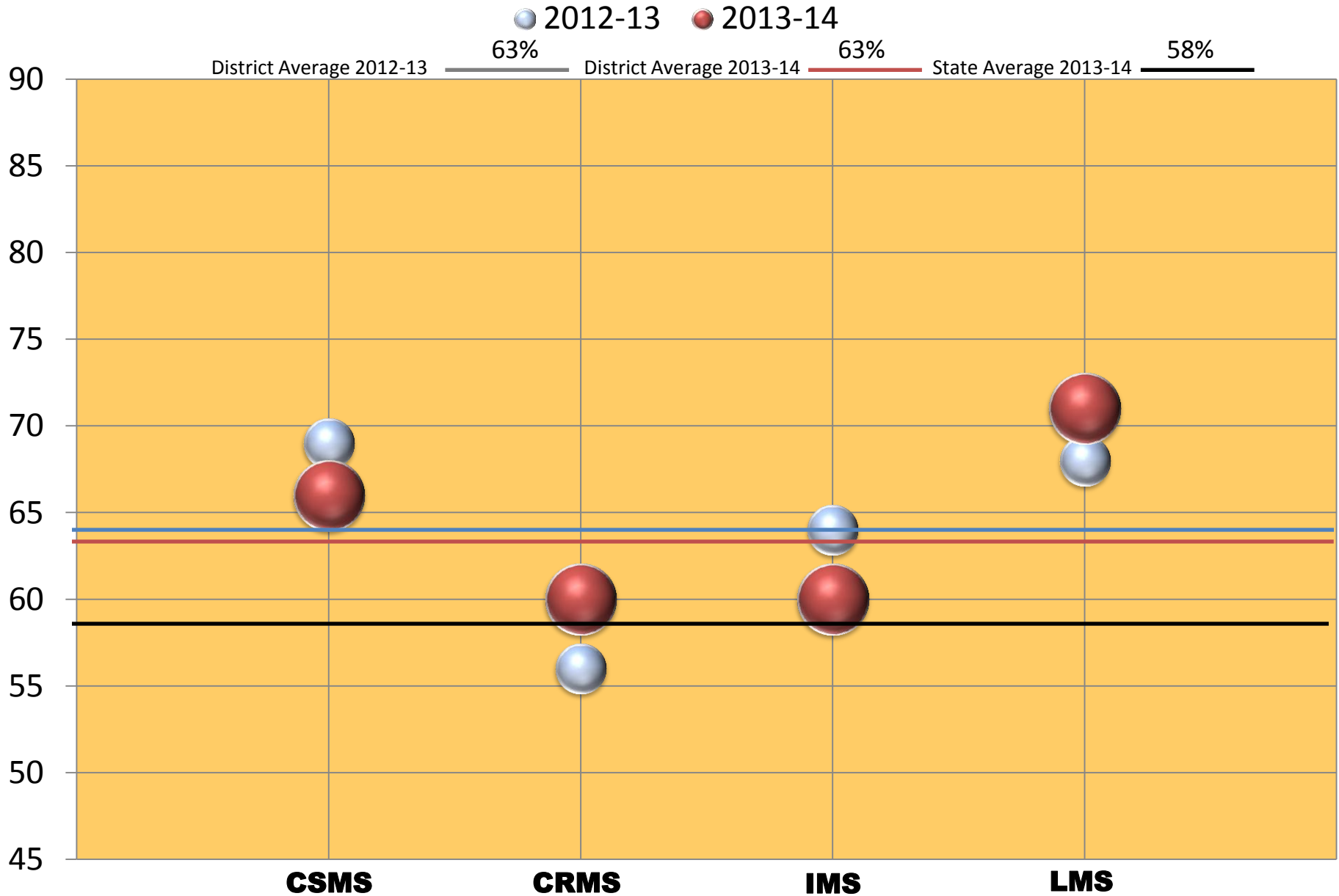
# FCAT 2.0 WRITING: Percent Proficient 3.5 > Grade 4



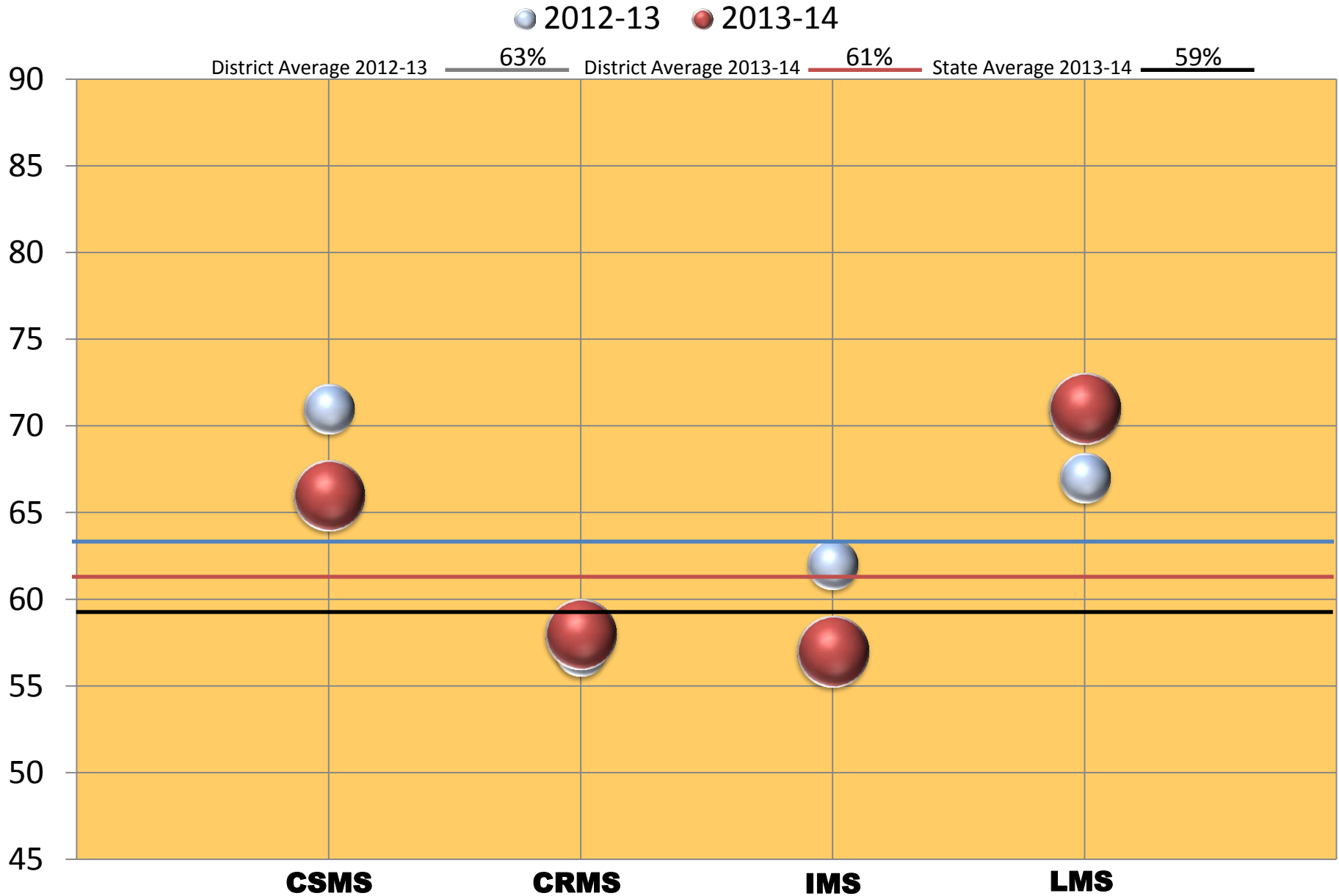
# FCAT 2.0 SCIENCE: Percent Proficient Grade 5



# FCAT 2.0 READING: Percent Proficient Grades 6-8

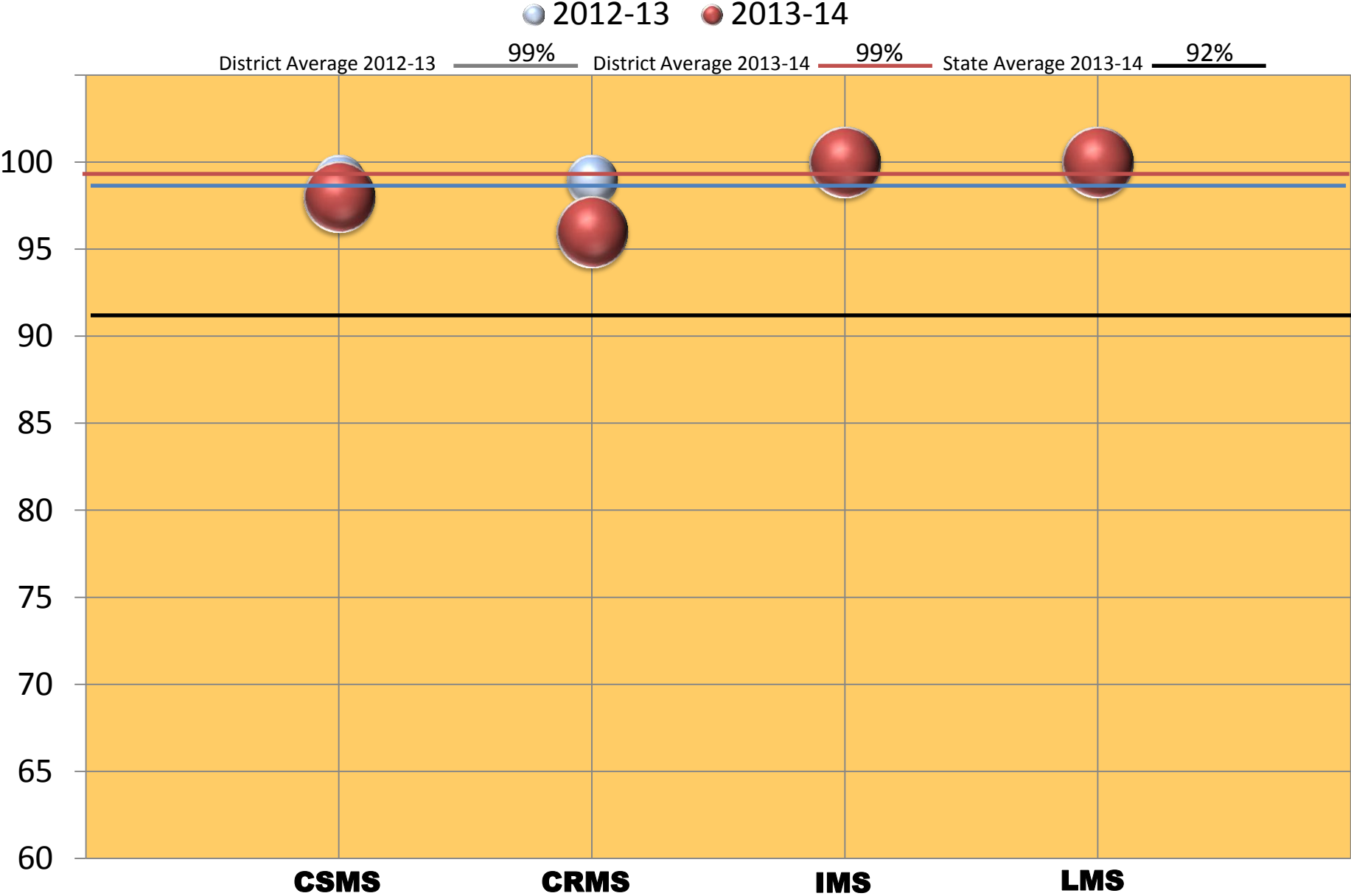

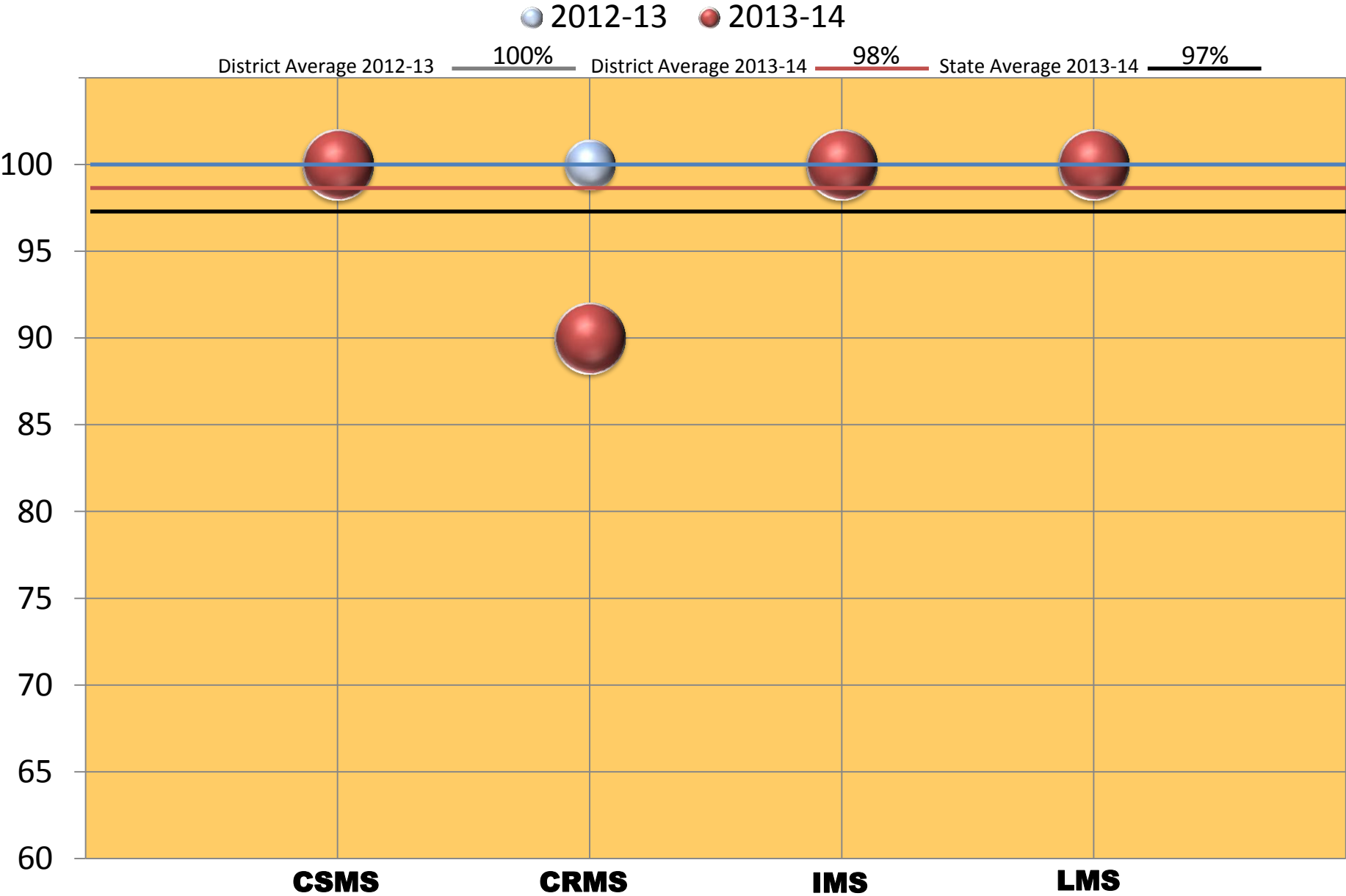




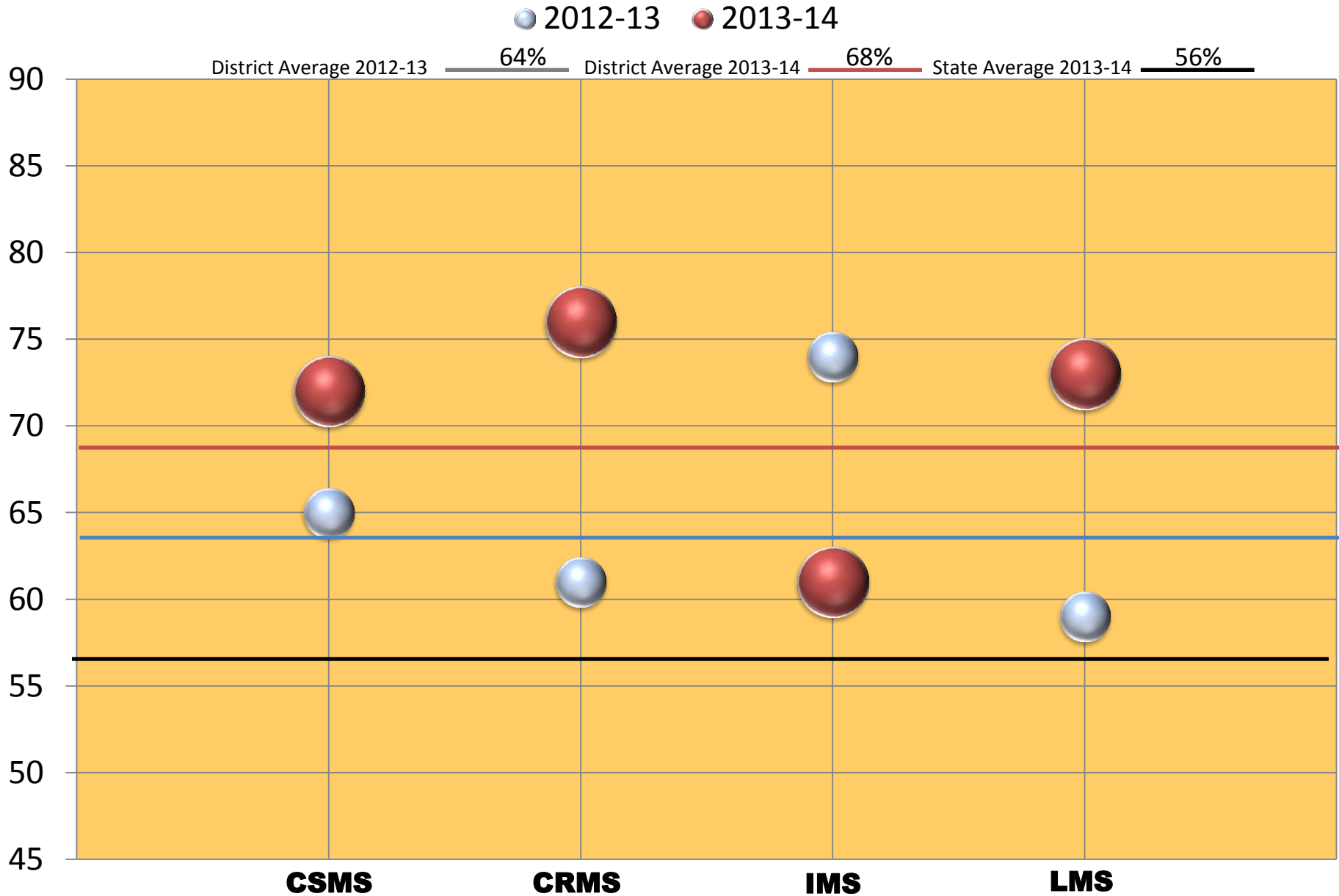
# ALGEBRA 1 EOC: Percent Proficient Grades 7-8



# GEOMETRY EOC: Percent Proficient Grade 8



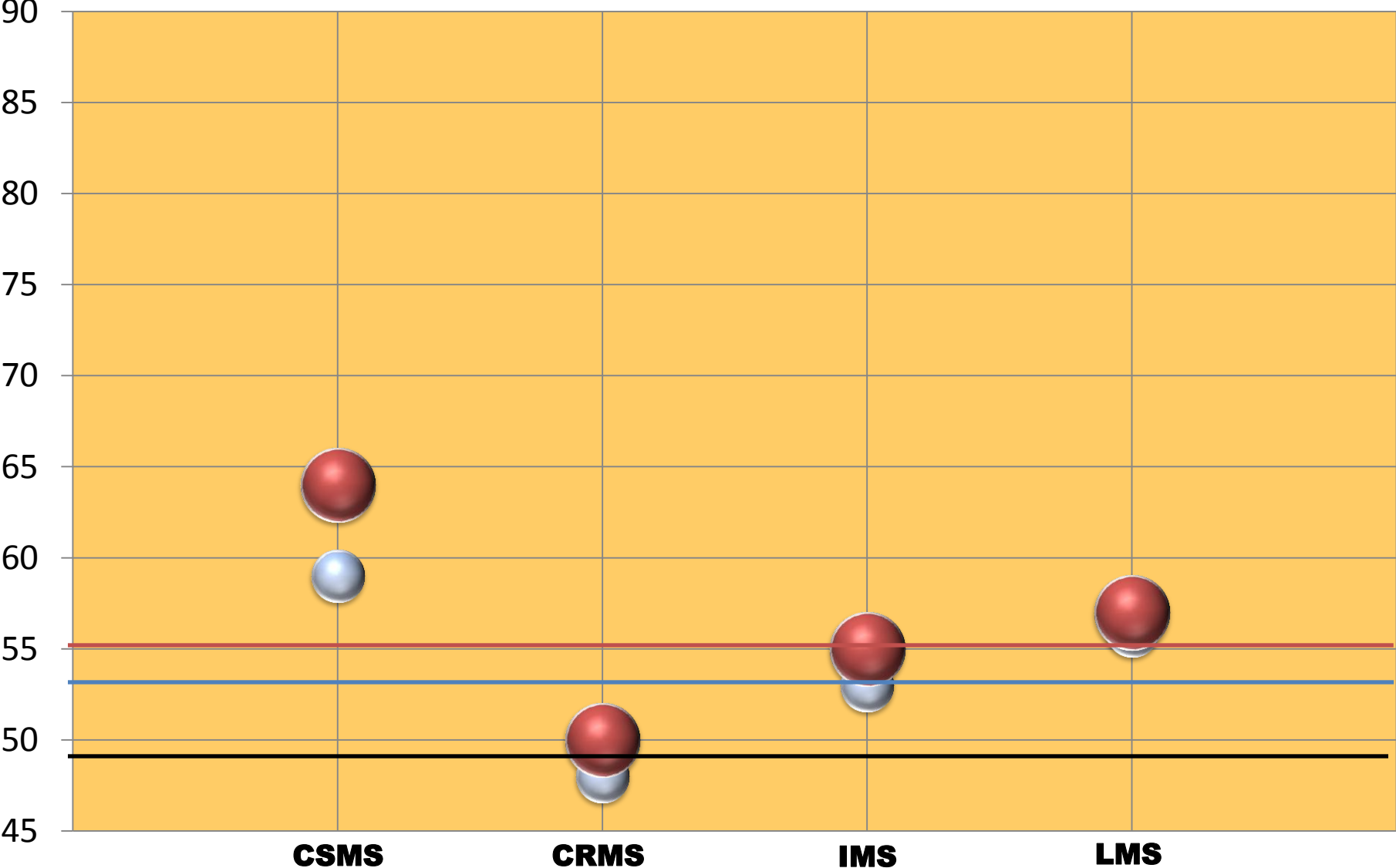

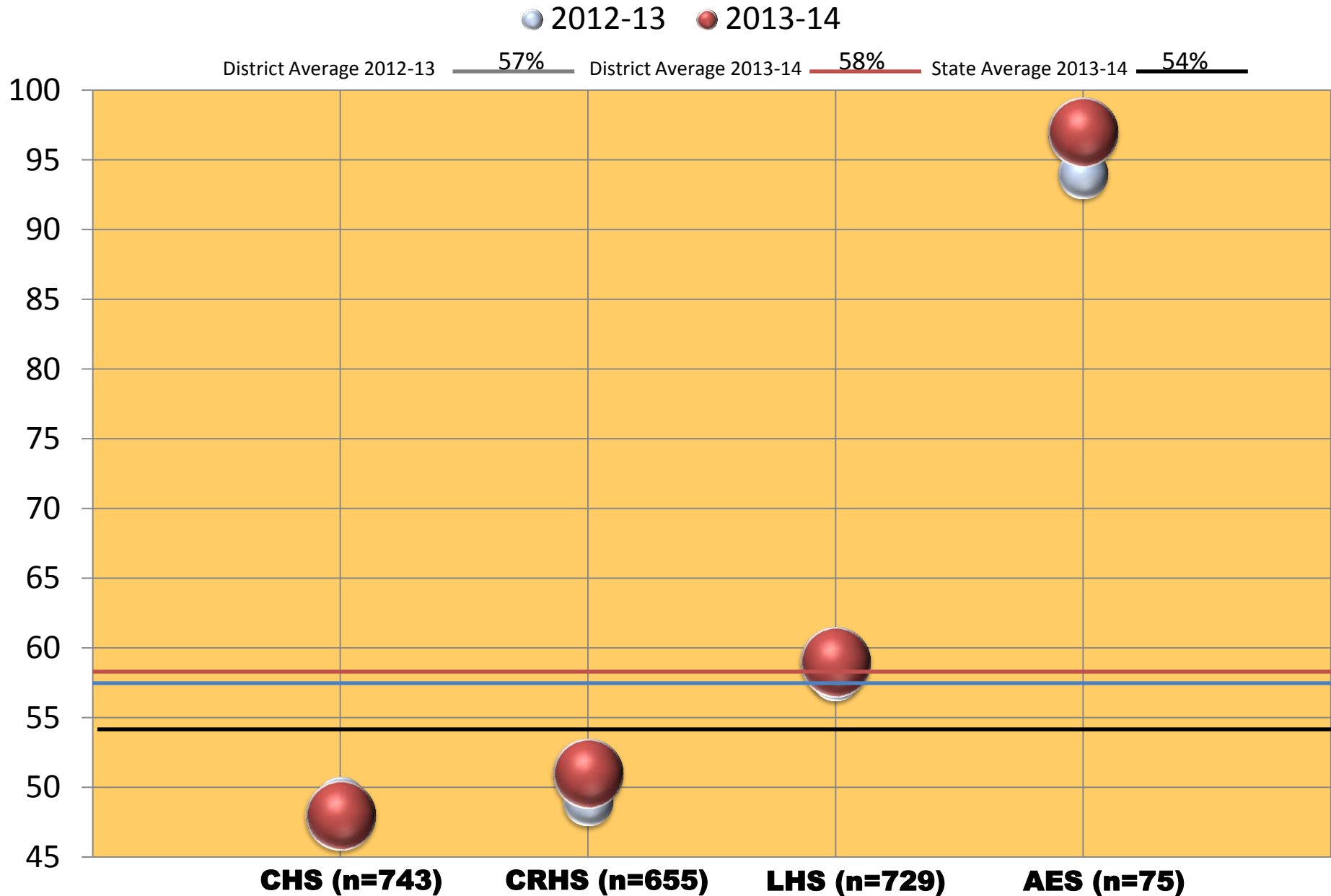

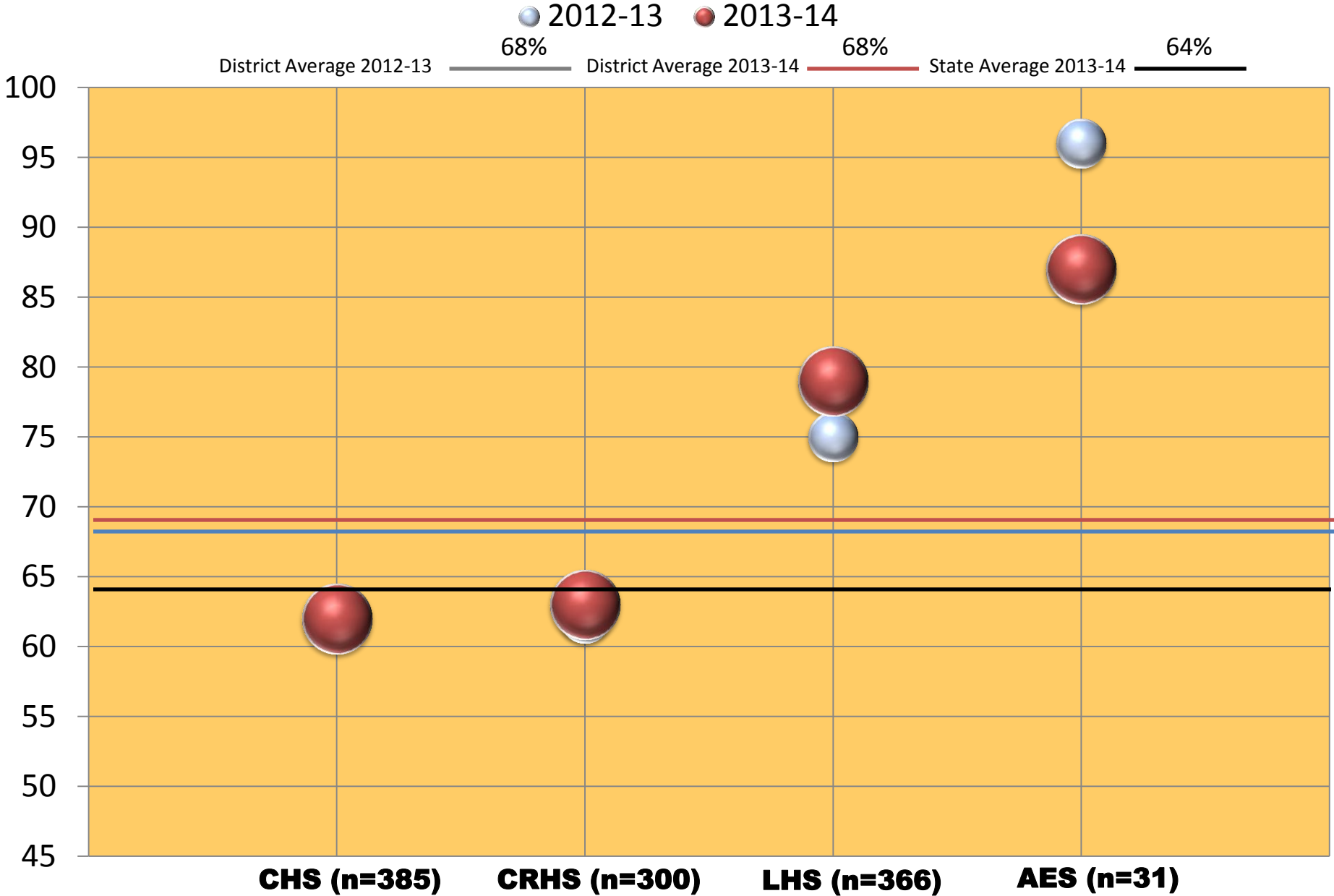

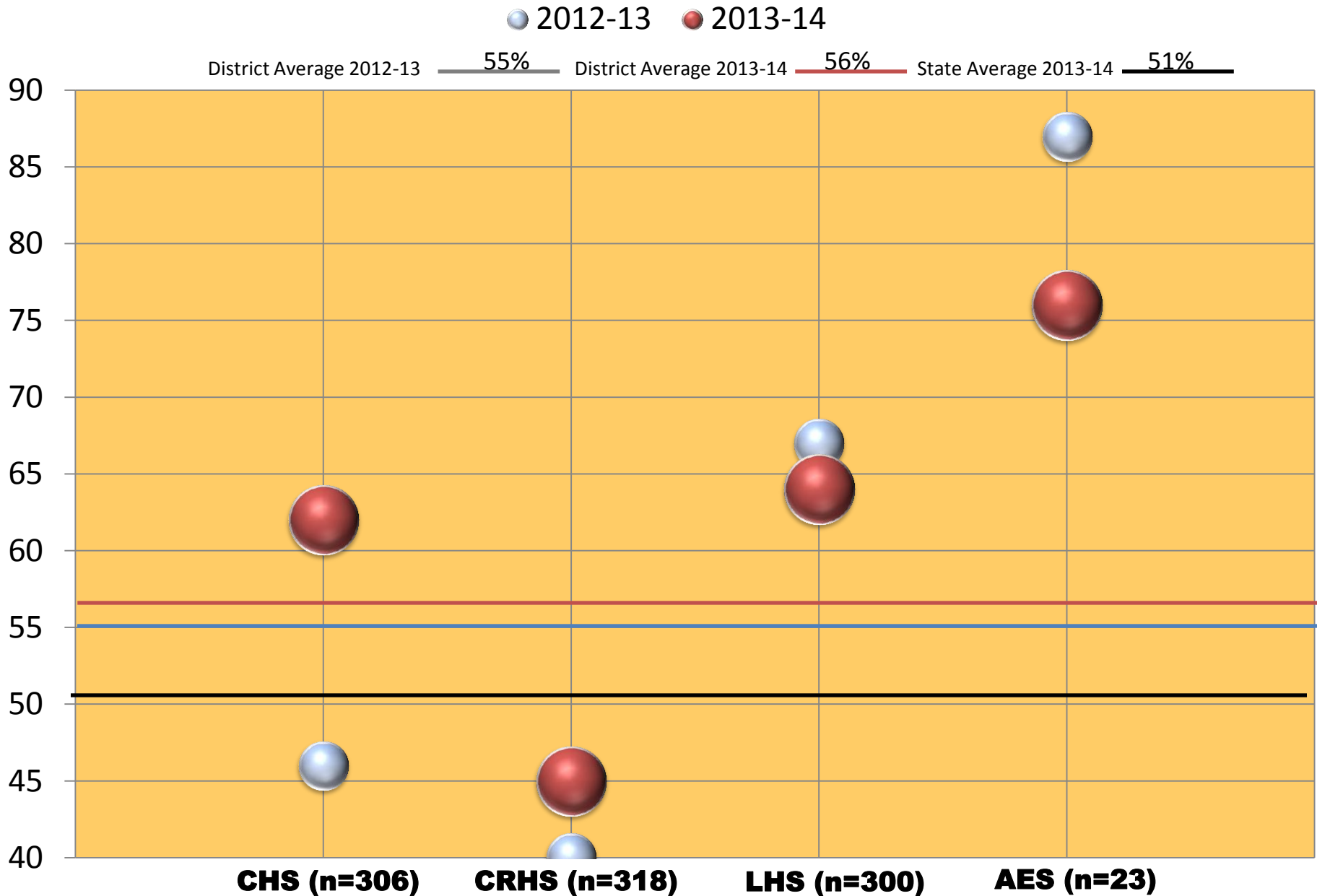
# FCAT 2.0 READING: Percent Proficient Grades 9-10



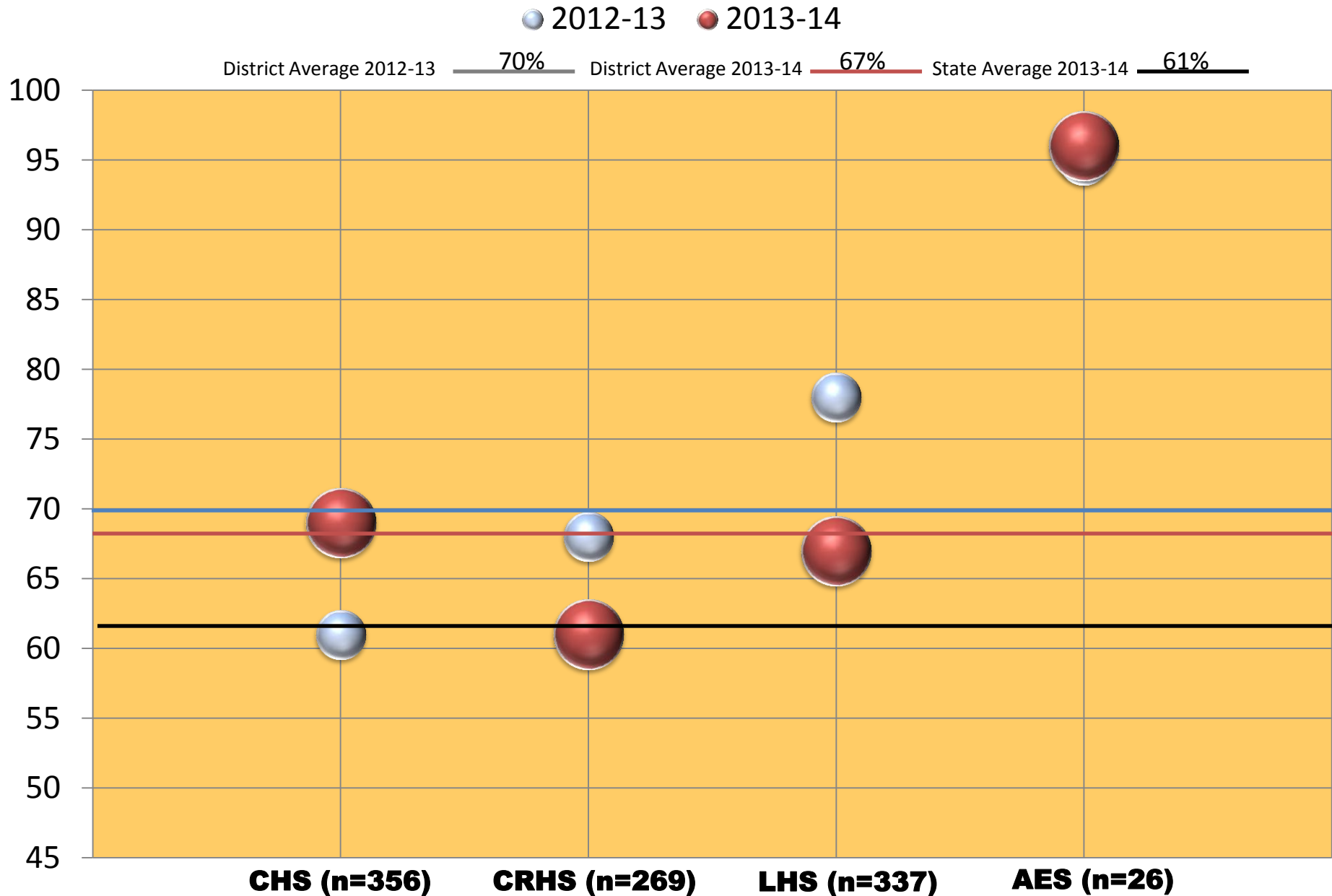
# FCAT 2.0 WRITING: Percent Proficient 3.5 > Grade 10



# ALGEBRA 1 EOC: Percent Proficient Grades 9-12

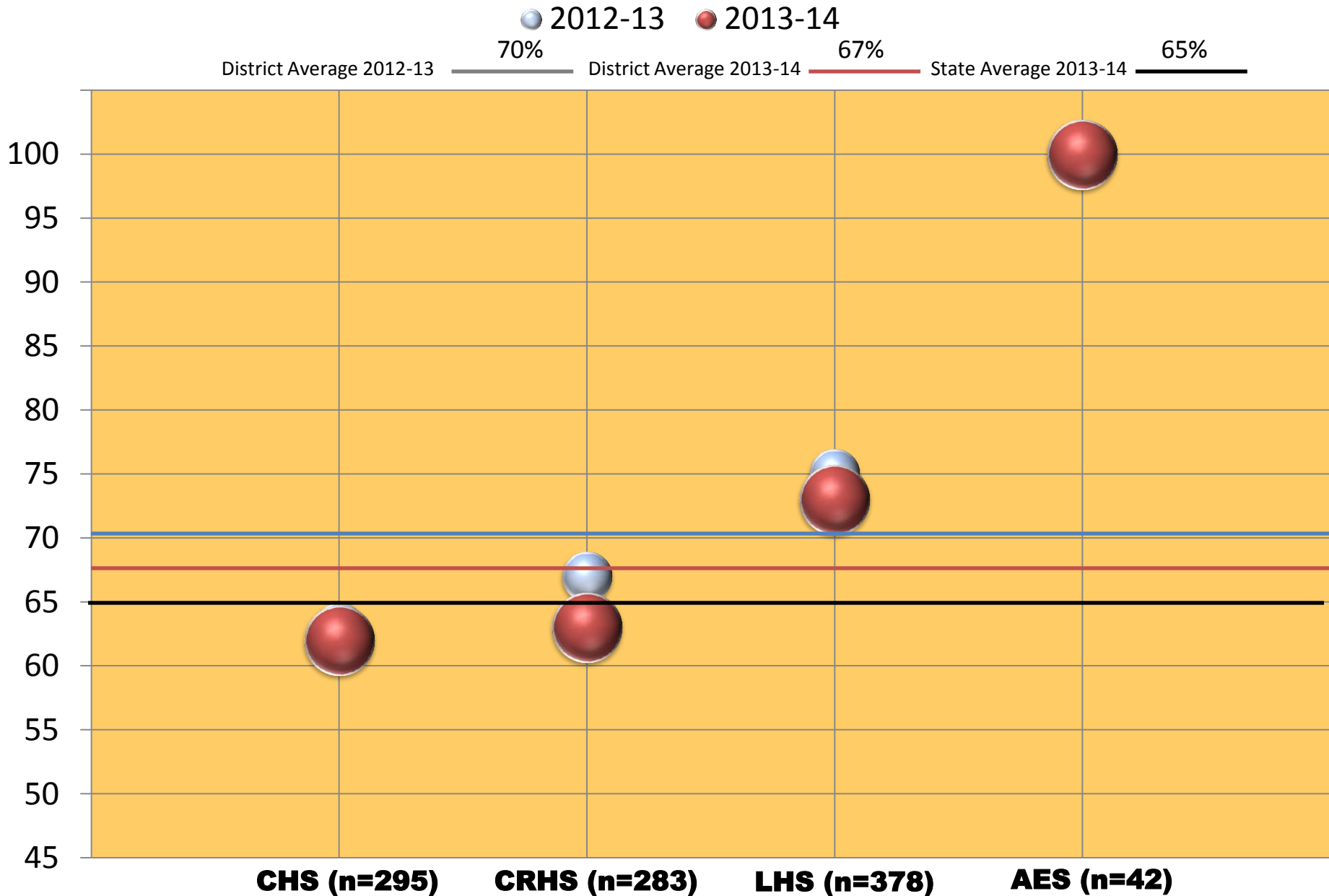


# GEOMETRY EOC: Percent Proficient Grades 9-12

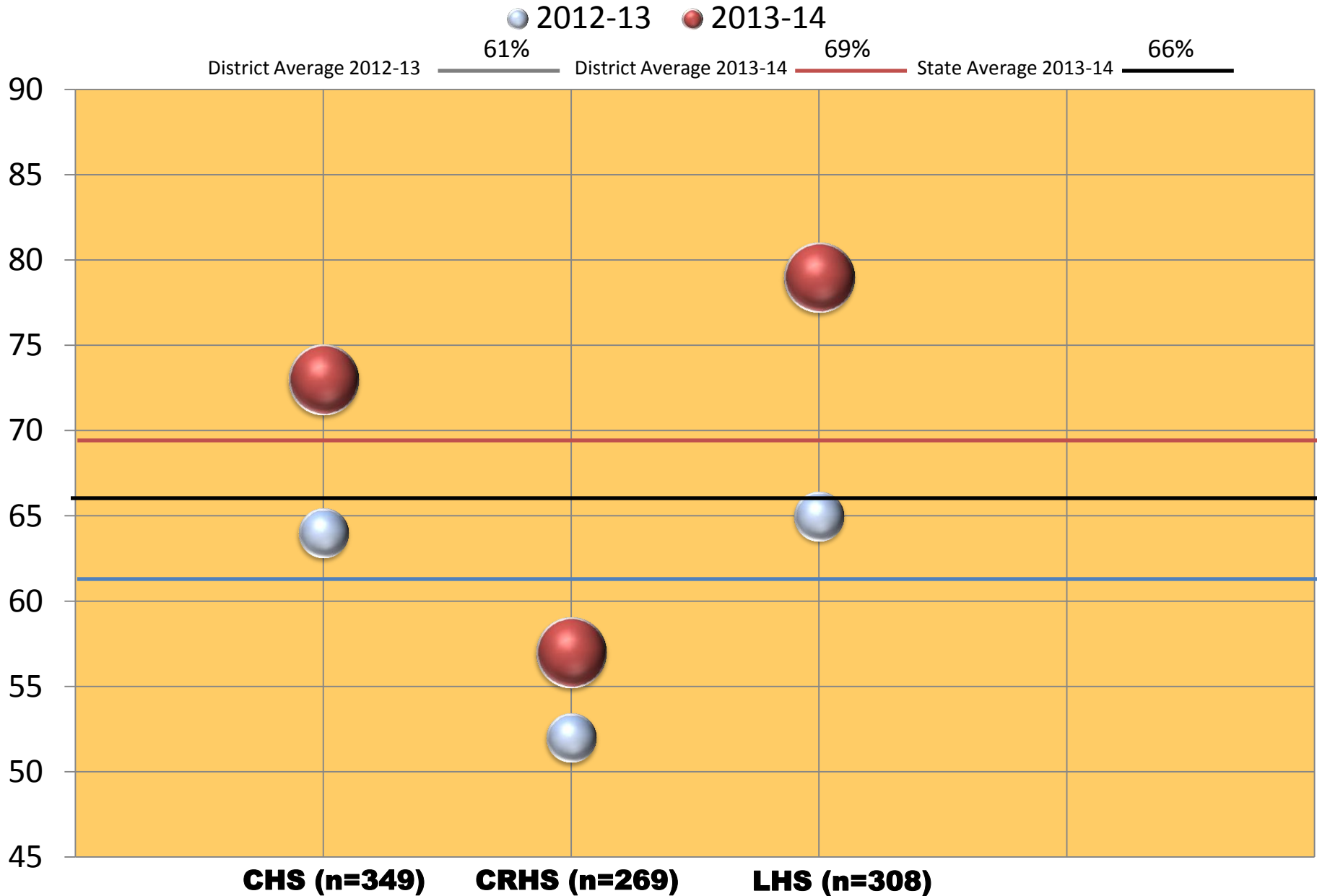




# BIOLOGY 1 EOC: Percent Proficient Grades 9-12




